

AJ2010 GEAR LIST

Need some help deciding what to pack for the Jamboree? This gear list will help you decided what to take and what not to take. This list is only a guide. Your Troop and Contingent may advise you of additional items to take.

CLOTHING

- Scout Uniform – everything except your group scarf and hat
- Coat hangers, plastic cover (dry-cleaning style) for uniform
- Contingent Shirt (if supplied)
- Troop Shirt (if supplied)
- Jamboree Scarf (and woggle of your choice)
- Hat (wide-brimmed or bucket hat)
- Socks (5 pairs, minimum)
- Underwear (6 pairs, minimum)
- Pyjamas (2 pairs)
- Polo Shirts i.e. with collar (3 extra - no Singlet tops allowed)
- Shorts (cotton preferable, 3 minimum)
- Pants (long pants e.g. track pants, jeans)
- Jumper
- Rain coat
- Enclosed shoes (2 pair, 1 must be for your uniform)
- Aqua shoes (not Crocs – must be secure and enclosed)
- Thongs (for use in shower only)
- Swimming costume

ESSENTIALS

- Dry washing powder in zip-lock bag (enough for three washes)
- Sunscreen
- Lip balm
- Insect repellent - roll-on or pump/trigger spray
- Personal first aid kit (including bandaids)
- Torch and spare batteries
- Sleeping bag, Inner Sheet (optional but recommended) & pillow
- Stretcher
- Personal toiletries (to include toothbrush, toothpaste, roll-on or stick deodorant, soap (in a container), shampoo, talcum powder, comb/brush, face washer)
- Tissues or 8 handkerchiefs
- Bath towel
- Old beach towel
- Mess kit – 2 Tea towels, large plate, cup, bowl, knife, fork, spoon, teaspoon
- Plastic bag (for dirty/wet clothes)
- Pegs – to hang out washing (12 minimum)
- Ground sheet – 1.8m x 1.2m tarp – to sit on when watching outdoor movie at night
- Housewife (Needle, thread, safety pins)
- Shoe cleaning brush (polish not required)
- Pencil case clearly marked with name – for storing valuables/medication in locked security box
- Zip-lock bag for medication - clearly marked with name and dosage - to be stored in secure cooled area (if required by manufacturers of the medication). Medication should be stored in a Webster Pack.

OPTIONAL EXTRAS

- Water Bottle (bring it empty!)
- Sunglasses
- Wristwatch
- Camera

- Small zip-lock bag or container for storing swap badges
- Deck of cards/small games (for free time)

DO NOT BRING

Aerosol cans (of any description), matches, mobile phones, mp3 players, electronic games, folding chairs, pocket knives, expensive jewellery, excessive cash.
